

Plan a Feast for Your Family

Here are a few ideas for planning your family celebration.

(before you set a date, make sure to wait until Covid19 is under control)

1. Talk to mom and/or dad first. Then set a date and a time (will it be a breakfast, lunch or dinner celebration?)
2. Make up your invitation list – who do you want to share this happy time with?
3. Make up your menu – what delicious foods will you offer your guests? Will you design your menu with a theme like “foods that start with the letter C” or “my favourite foods”?
4. Set up your table seating plan
5. Design some special placemats for every guest
6. How will you decorate for your celebration?
7. Design your invitations – make sure to include all the important information like date, time, theme (if you have one) and place. Do you want to celebrate a special occasion like a birthday or Earth day or something that makes you happy? If yes, include that on your invitation. (don't forget to send them)
8. Make sure to ask your guests to RSVP which means to please let you know by a certain date if they are coming or not – it makes it easier to plan if you know how many guests will be there.
9. Make sure you help set up before and clean up after your celebration.
10. Thank your guests for coming. Thank Jesus for watching over everyone. Ask God to bless your friends, family and food. Then enjoy your celebration!
