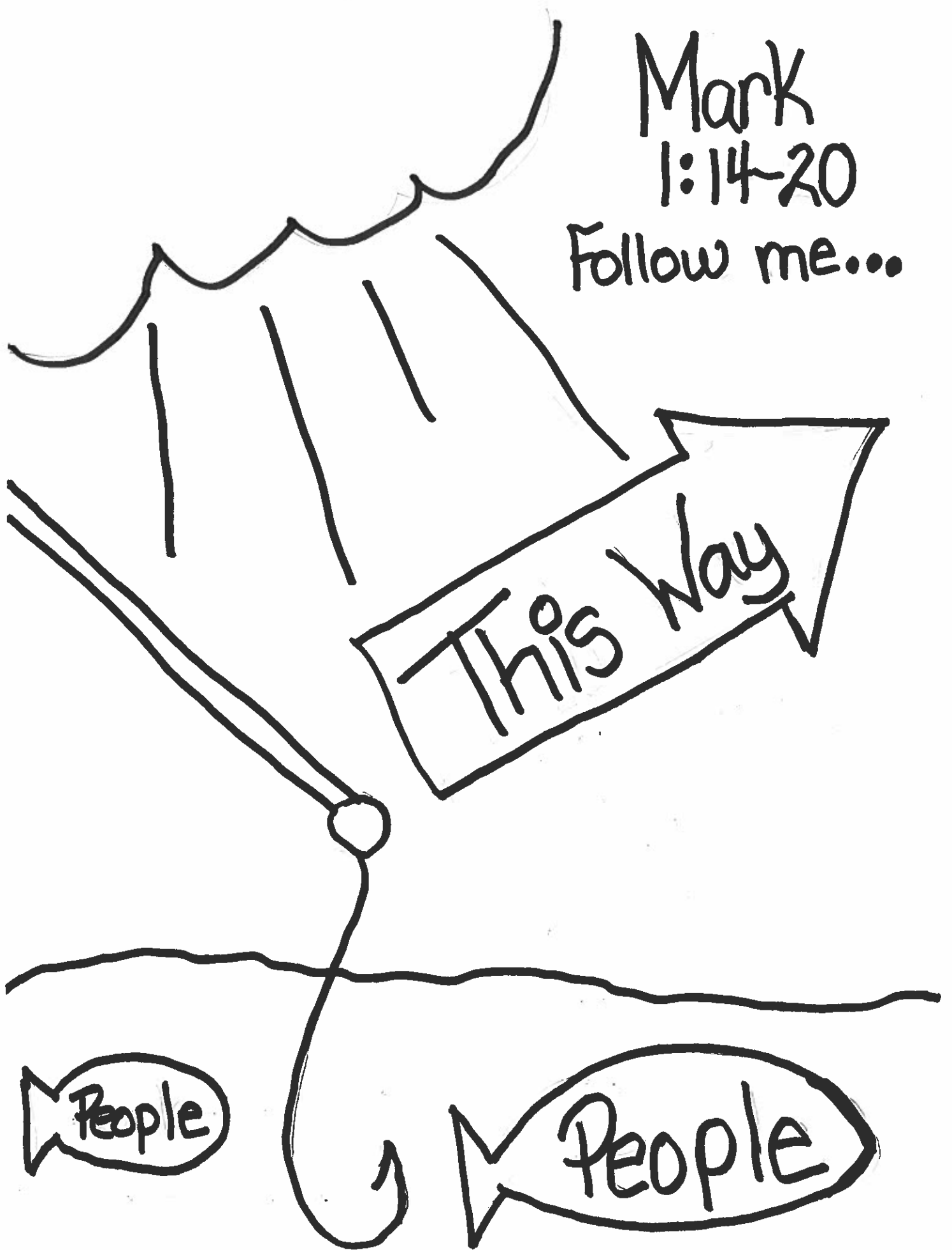
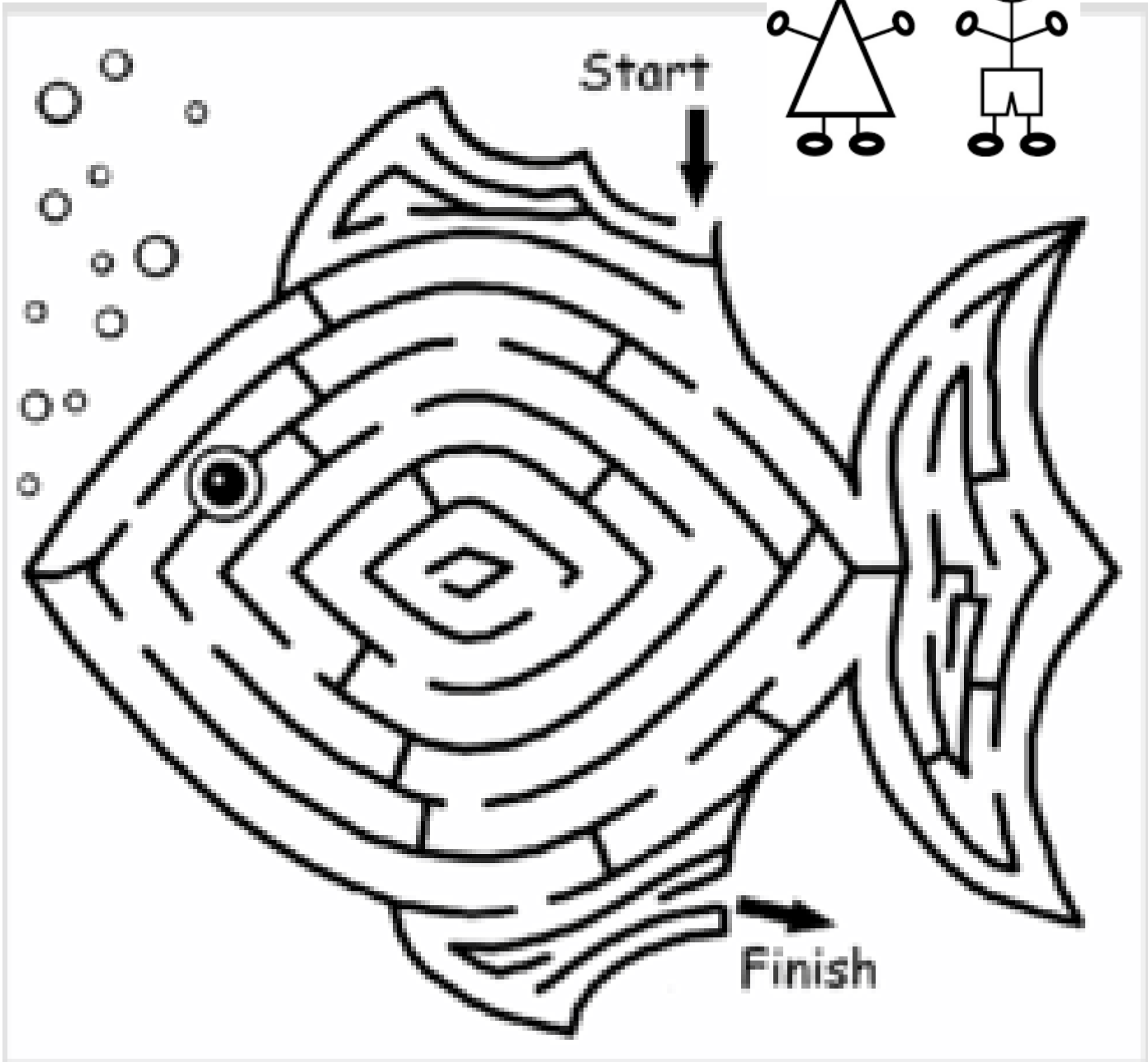

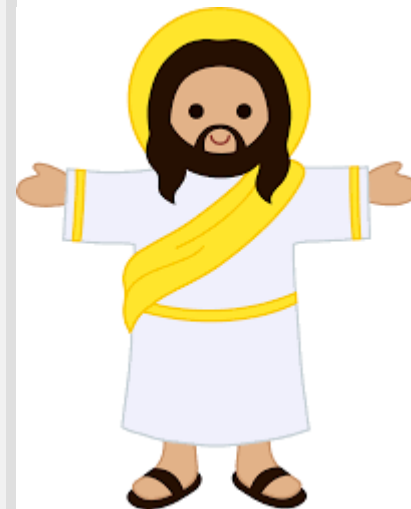

Fish Craft for Sunday School, Jan. 24, 2021

3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Supplies needed: paper with fish outlines (either hand drawn or printed from the parish website), colouring pencils, crayons or markers, hole punch, scissors, tape, string or ribbon, a piece of dowl or a sturdy stick

Instructions

1. Print or draw your own fish outlines. Make sure you have one fish for every member of your family
2. Colour the fish and label each one with the name of your family member (including you)
3. Cut out each fish
4. Make a hole (preferably with a hole punch) on your fish – this is where the string will go through
5. String each fish and secure the tie with tape
6. Attach each string to your fishing pole
7. Hang your fishing pole so you can see all the names
