Sunday School Craft Page 1

Directions – page 2 and 3 have the parts you will need for the craft

Supplies – scissors, pages 2 and 3, crayons or markers, string, glue or tape

Print as many pages as you need – one fish for every member of your family, one boat

Colour and put the name of each of your family members on a fish (page 2)

Cut the fish out

Cut pieces of string or ribbon about 6 inches long – one for each fish

Colour the parts of the boat – page 3

Cut out the shapes and fold the 2 triangles, the rectangle and the circle in half

Cut along the fold so you end up with one large sail, one smaller sail, the mast and the boat

Glue the boat together (you now have enough pieces to make another boat)

Glue the piece of string to the bottom of the boat – leave string to hang down

Glue each of your fish to the other end of the string

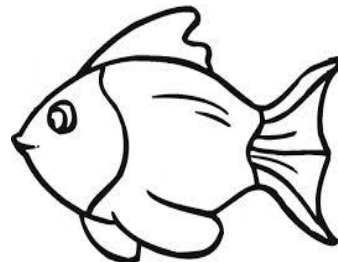
Mount the finished fishing boat where you and your family can see it as a reminder that Jesus caught us in his net of love

Print as many as you need to include all your family members

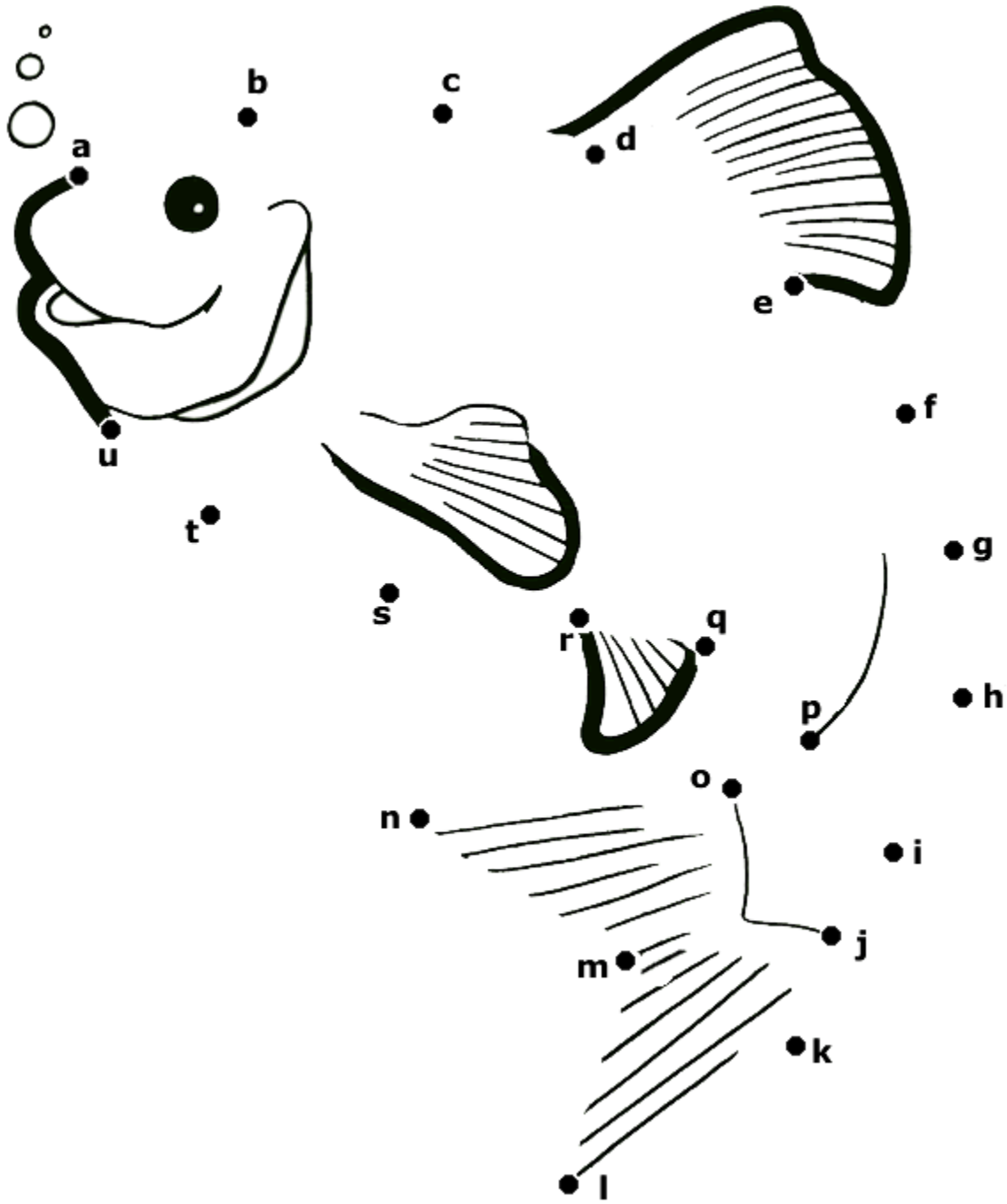




Fold each piece in half and construct a sailboat
